Day	Itinerary	Accommodation
1	Meet at Cape Town International Airport for our flight to Tel Aviv, Israel. Dinner on board.	In flight
2	After breakfast on the flight, we arrive in Tel Aviv and depart for the Jordanian Border in a luxury air-conditioned bus. After crossing the border we visit the ancient City of <b>Jerash</b> before moving on to <b>Amman</b> .	Amman
3	We visit the <b>Royal Automobile Museum</b> in Amman. Depart for Petra stopping at <b>Shobak Castle</b> along the way.	Petra
4	Visit <b>Petra</b> with breath taking views of this amazing city carved out of rose coloured rock. In the late afternoon departure to <b>Wadi Rum</b> for a desert experience in 4x4 vehicles, climbing dunes, admiring huge ochre coloured rock pinnacles and spending the night in tents for the ultimate Bedouin experience.	Wadi Rum
5	We head back for Amman, on route visiting the world famous <b>Madaba Map</b> and <b>Mount Nebo</b> , where Moses had sight of the Promised Land before he died. We travel to the Israel border crossing and make our way to <b>Jerusalem</b> . Introduction to the <b>Old City of Jerusalem</b> .	Jerusalem
6	Visit the <b>Pools of Siloam, Mary's Spring, Birthplace of John the Baptist</b> and the <b>Holocaust Museum</b> .	Jerusalem
7	We travel to <b>Jericho</b> where Joshua and his people entered the Holy Land. Here we visit the <b>Fountain of Elisha</b> and see the <b>Mount of Temptation</b> . On route to Masada we see the caves of <b>Qumran</b> where the Dead Sea scrolls were "accidentally" discovered by a local shepherd boy in 1947. At <b>Masada</b> we take a cable car up the mountain to the ancient fortress of Herod the Great. We then travel to the lowest place on earth – the <b>Dead Sea</b> for the unique opportunity to float on the salty mineral waters of the Dead Sea.	Jerusalem
8	Visit <b>Mount of Olives, Pater Noster</b> , where Jesus taught His disciples the Lord's Prayer and then on to the <b>Dominus Flevit</b> (Teardrop church) where Jesus lamented over Jerusalem. Thereafter we visit the <b>Garden of Gethsemane as well as the Church of all Nations</b> . At <b>Mount Zion</b> we visit the church of <b>St. Peter in Gallicantu</b> , where Peter denied Jesus and see the ancient ruins of <b>Caiaphas' house</b> where the Lord Jesus Christ was taken on the night of His arrest. We visit the <b>Upper Room</b> where Jesus and His disciples partook of the Last Supper as well as <b>King David's Tomb</b> . Then on to <b>Bethlehem</b> to visit the birthplace of Jesus and the <b>Shepherds Fields</b> .	Jerusalem
9	Today we visit the <b>Wailing Wall, Temple Mount, Pools of Bethesda</b> and follow the <b>Via Dolorosa</b> . We visit the <b>Cardo</b> and examine part of the <b>Original City Wall</b> that Nehemiah built. Following this we explore the <b>Jewish Quarter</b> and end the day with the <b>Western Wall Tunnels</b>	Jerusalem
10	We leave Jerusalem and travel to <b>Caesarea</b> to see an ancient <b>Aqueduct</b> . Then on to <b>Mount Carmel</b> , where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal followed by <b>Megiddo</b> where we overlook the breath taking <b>Valley of Jezreel</b> (where the Battle of Armageddon will take place). In <b>Nazareth</b> we visit the <b>Nazareth Village</b> to experience village life in the 1st Century AD. Following this we visit <b>Cana</b> , where Jesus turned water into wine.	Tiberias
11	We sail on the Sea of Galilee in a replica boat from the time of Christ. We visit places along the <b>Sea of Galilee</b> where Jesus travelled, preached and performed many miracles, including <b>Capernaum, Tabgha, the Mount of Beatitudes</b> and the <b>St Peter's Primacy Church</b> . The day ends with a visit to the Yardnit Baptismal Site on the <b>Jordan River</b> .	Jerusalem
12	A visit to <b>Golgotha</b> – place of the Skull – where Jesus was probably crucified and the <b>Garden Tomb</b> where we celebrate the Lord's Supper. The rest of the day is at leisure. Then in the early evening it is time to make our way to the airport for our flight back to South Africa.	In flight
13	Arrive back in South Africa.
