

REQUIREMENTS FOR ISRAEL:-

- The tourist must be **fully vaccinated** with a WHO approved vaccine which is recognised by Israel (Moderna, Pfizer, Johnson & Johnson – Janssen, AstraZeneca, Covishield, Sinopharm, Sinovac, Sputnik-V as set out in the terms, conditions and requirements below:-

***Pfizer/Moderna/AstraZeneca/Sinovac or Sinopharm:-**

-If you have completed a course of 2 vaccine shots and upon your entry to Israel at least 14 days must have passed since you received your second vaccine shot (but no more than 180 days upon leaving Israel)

-if you have received a booster shot, then upon entry to Israel at least 14 days must have passed since you received your booster shot.

***Johnson & Johnson – Janssen vaccine:-**

-At least 14 days must have passed since your vaccination date (but no more than 180 days upon leaving Israel)

-If you have received a booster dose then upon entry to Israel, at least 14 days must have passed since you received your booster shot.

***Sputnik vaccine:-**

-Foreigners vaccinated with this vaccine as of 15/11/2021 and who have tested positive in a serological COVID antibody test taken in Israel (You must remain in isolation until a positive result is obtained)

-You must have completed a course of two vaccine doses, and upon entry to Israel at least 14 days must have passed since you received your second vaccine shot (but no more than 180 days upon leaving Israel)

-If you have received a booster dose then upon entry to Israel, at least 14 days must have passed since you received your booster shot.

***Entry to Israel for persons fully recovered from Covid:-**

Foreign Nationals who have recovered from COVID will be allowed to enter Israel if they have a digital certificate that can be authenticated by the Israeli Ministry of Health Systems and based on a positive result in a NAAT test (molecular test similar to PCR)

-Upon entry to Israel at least 11 days must have passed since the positive test result (but no more than 190 days upon departure from Israel)

-You must have received at least one dose of a WHO-approved vaccine (there is no significance to the order of events)

- Negative PCR test taken in South Africa within 72 hours before the flight to Israel. Proof of the negative result is required in order to board the plane. Travellers are responsible for arranging and undertaking of this test as well as bearing the cost thereof (Approx **R850**).
- For travellers to Israel an online entry statement must be completed. Holders of verifiable digital vaccination certificates must attach this to the entry statement declaration form. They will receive a Green Pass before boarding the flight. If the traveller does not hold a verifiable digital certificate, the traveller must specify the vaccines received on the entry statement for travellers coming to Israel and attach proof to this online form. The traveller will receive a Green pass before boarding the flight.
- Just before boarding the flight, the traveller must present the following documents:-
 - One of the following: Proof of a negative result on a PCR test taken within 72 hours before the flight to Israel or proof of a positive PCR Test taken more than 11 days ago but less than three months beforehand
 - Confirmation of completion of the entry statement form for travellers coming to Israel
 - One of the following documents: A vaccination certificate proving vaccination in accordance with the protocol set by Israel or a digital recovery certificate or a special entry permit or an Israeli passport
 - A passenger must agree to random inspections of documents & meet requirements of the Population & Immigration Authority at Ben Gurion International Airport.
- A second PCR test to be taken upon arrival in Israel at the airport and quarantine for 24 hours or until a negative result is received, whichever comes first. However our Israeli agent will make arrangements so that results are available within 2 – 3 hours so one can leave the airport. PCR test costs approx. **\$30** and is for your own cost.
- Health declaration that should be filled in online 24 hours before arrival

- Arrival point must be Ben Gurion Airport
- Tourist must not have visited RED countries 14 days before arrival in Israel
- If the country is suddenly RED, the group will not be allowed to enter
- Only vaccines recognised by the WHO will be accepted plus Russia's Sputnik V vaccine which has special conditions and requires an additional serological test upon arrival.
- If PCR test at Ben Gurion airport shows positive the COVID patient is required to quarantine in hotels that the Ministry of Health in Israel decides at his / her own cost.

REQUIREMENTS FOR JORDAN:-

- Before traveling to Jordan you must register your details on the Visit Jordan Platform to get QR Code (<https://www.gateway2jordan.gov.jo/index.html>) and pre-book your arrival PCR test
- Negative COVID-19 PCR test at most 72 hours prior to arrival in Jordan
- Negative PCR test 72 hours prior to departure from Jordan (arranged for you by our Israeli & Jordanian agent). Cost approx. **\$30** and is for your own cost.
- Valid Travel and Health insurance that would include COVID 19 related expenses & treatment
- Vaccination certificate otherwise a PCR test upon arrival at the Jordanian land border is required

REQUIREMENTS FOR SOUTH AFRICA

- A Dept of Health Republic of SA Health Questionnaire: exit screening to be completed by the traveller before departure from SA. Travel Time Tours will provide you with this form.
- A Dept of Health Republic of SA Health Questionnaire: entry screening to be completed by the traveller before departure from Israel. Travel Time Tours will provide you with this form.
- A negative PCR test is required when re-entering SA that is not older than 72 hours from your time of departure with a QR code. Arrangements for this will be made by our Israeli agent & Travel Time Tours to be undertaken at a hotel in Jerusalem. The test is for your own cost (Approx **\$32**)
