At <b>Masada</b> we take a cable car up the mountain to the ancient fortress of Herod the Great. Thereafter we visit the <b>Garden of Gethsemane as well as the Church of all Nations</b> . At <b>Mount Zion</b> we visit the church of <b>St. Peter in Gallicantu</b> , where Peter denied Jesus and see the ancient ruins of <b>Caiaphas' house</b> where the Lord Jesus Christ was taken on the night of His arrest. We visit the <b>Upper Room</b> where Jesus and His disciples partook of the Last Supper as well as <b>King David's Tomb</b> .
